





#### **Twinning Learning Programme**

Donor: NetZeroCities, European Union

A 12-month peer-learning and exchange programme starting in November 2025, matching non-Mission "Twin Cities" with leading "Mission Cities." Focus is on sharing experience and climate actions defined in the Climate City Contracts to accelerate urban climate neutrality through tailored workshops, site visits, expert support, and structured learning modules.

Eligibility: Mission-minded cities (beyond the 112 EU Mission Cities), from the EU or Horizon Europe associated countries, aiming for climate neutrality by 2050 or earlier.
