- Policy to secure developers contributions
- Strategic analysis of quantity and quality
 - Cross cutting strategy
 - £3.8M investment over 8 years infrastructure
 - Mixture of developers contributions, external funding and HBBC (£1.4M)
 - Parish Fund
- Merged green spaces and grounds maintenance
- Five year delivery plan. £0.5M investment over five years (only £75K from HBBC)
 - Gaps in provision, green infrastructure, biodiversity, community, informal green space
- **2016** Commercial opportunities, retaining maintenance in-house

- Two tier system collection and disposal.
- Currently recycle **51.8%** (reducing 1% per year).
- Three wheeled bins refuse, dry recycling (glass separate) and garden waste.
