Green Spaces Journey

- 2001** • Policy to secure developers contributions

- 2005** • Strategic analysis of quantity and quality
 - Cross cutting strategy
 - £3.8M investment over 8 years – infrastructure
 - Mixture of developers contributions, external funding and HBBC (£1.4M)
 - Parish Fund

- 2009** • Merged green spaces and grounds maintenance

- 2014** • Five year delivery plan. £0.5M investment over five years (only £75K from HBBC)
 - Gaps in provision, green infrastructure, biodiversity, community, informal green space

- 2016** • Commercial opportunities, retaining maintenance in-house

Waste Management

- **Two tier system** – collection and disposal.
- Currently recycle **51.8%** (reducing 1% per year).
- **Three wheeled bins** – refuse, dry recycling (glass separate) and garden waste.

- **Reduction in funding** – introduce charges, reduce costs, trade waste.
- **Future service design** – TEEP versus cost versus quantity.

How to use your recycling bin and caddy

Recycling caddy

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Catalogues
- ✓ Junk Mail
- ✓ Cardboard

Please put paper and cardboard only in the caddy
Large cardboard - flatten and place securely next to the bin

Recycling bin

All items must be washed and loose (not in plastic bags)

- ✓ Glass bottles and jars
- ✓ Food/drink tins and cans
- ✓ Cartons (tetrapaks)
- ✓ Foil
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Plastic bottles - shampoo, milk etc
- ✓ Plastic pots - yoghurt etc
- ✓ Plastic tubs - margarine, ice cream etc
- ✓ Plastic trays - meat, fruit etc (no black plastic)

✗ Remember all paper and card must be in the caddy

Sorry, we cannot empty this bin/caddy if it contains items we do not recycle. This includes:

- ✗ Plastic bags/carrier bags
- ✗ Cling film, plastic film & cellophane
- ✗ All types of black plastic
- ✗ Household rubbish
- ✗ Coat hangers
- ✗ Hard plastics eg toys
- ✗ Electrical items
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ Plant pots & trays
- ✗ Kitchen pots, pans & utensils
- ✗ Paint tins
- ✗ Bubblewrap
- ✗ Video cassettes, DVDs & CDs
- ✗ Wrapping/tissue paper
