





Inhulka municipality (Ukraine).

The municipality is comprised of 15 villages, and its total area is 478.4 km2 comprising the population of 8 379 people.

In March 2022, the Bashtanka district, where Inhulka municipality is located, was partially occupied by the russian armed forces. It was fully liberated by the Armed Forces of Ukraine on 10 November 2022.

The localities within the Inhulka municipality were established in early 19th century. Before the Russian invasion in 2022, the main sector of economy in Inhulka municipality was farming: production of cereals (winter wheat, barley, corn, industrial, vegetable crops, and horticulture).

On the territory of the municipality there are located:

- 8 secondary schools;
- 8 kindergartens;
- 9 village cultural centres;
- 7 village libraries;
- 4 paramedic and obstetric stations;
- 2 ambulance stations;
- 3 outpatient clinics of general practicioners;
- 2 psychoneurological boarding schools.
