## Emperor-Maximilian-Prize 2023 young-european-united

Dear Sir or Madam,

The Emperor-Maximilian-Prize of the City of Innsbruck and the Region of Tyrol offers the opportunity to highlight and honour projects and initiatives from all areas of life that actively practise European togetherness through their actions and activities. We are looking for pioneering projects that stand for a lively Europe beyond the municipal and/or regional level. On the one hand, these are to be awarded and supported with the earmarked prize money in the amount of  $\in$  10,000, on the other hand, they should also offer inspiration for further concepts.

Applications can be submitted until 20 April 2023 by using the application form in English on <u>www.emperormaximilianprize.at</u>.

In May 2023, the winner of all submissions will be selected by an expert jury composed of representatives of the City of Innsbruck, the Region of the Tyrol, the University of Innsbruck, the European Committee of the Regions, the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities, the Assembly of European Regions, as well as

the Council of European Municipalities and Regions.
