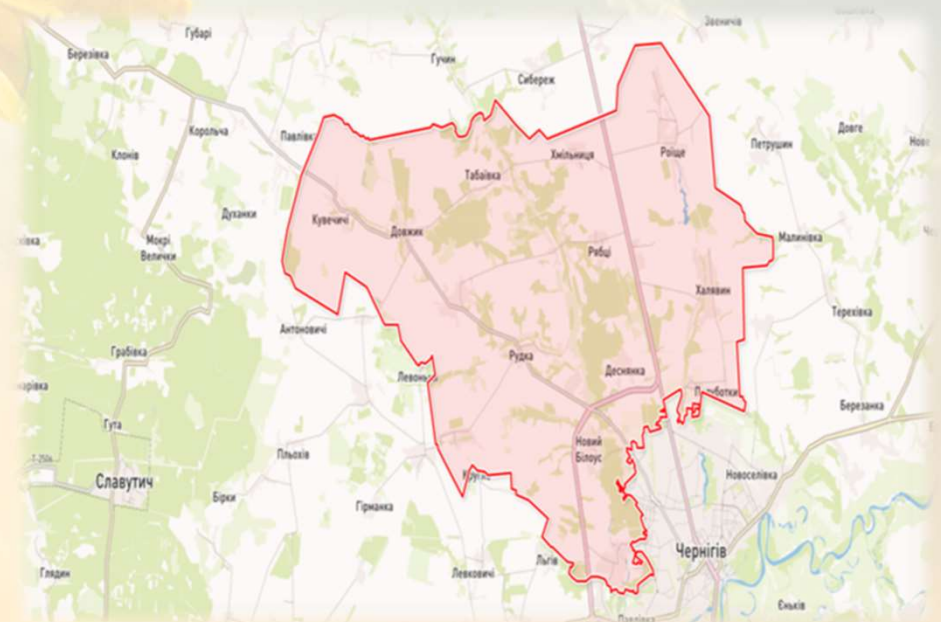

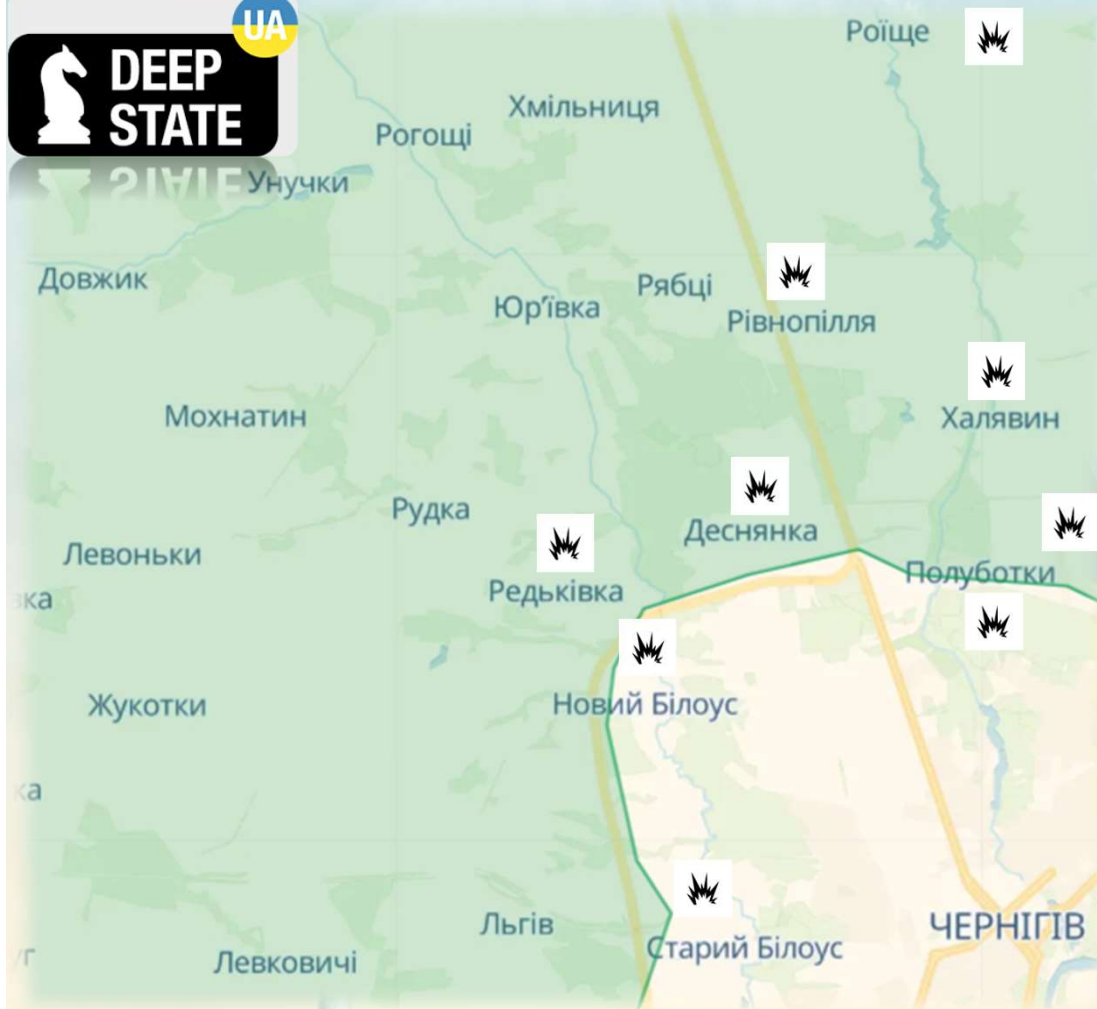
General Information



- The Novyi Bilous territorial community was created on July 17, 2019
- Administrative center: village of Novyi Bilous, str. Svyrydovskyi, 54
- The total area of the territory: 34,693.52 km²
- Population: on the 1st of January 2023 is 11,922 people
- As a result of decentralization, 10 former village councils of the Chernihiv district, which included 22 settlements created the community
- The composition of the deputy corps of the village council includes 22 deputies
- The total amount of the community budget in 2023 is 132.8 million. UAH or 3.31 million euros (according to the official exchange rate of the NBU on the 1st of May, 2023)
- 9 schools, 8 pre-school institutions, 14 cultural institutions are maintained at the expense of the community budget, partially maintained
- 4 medical clinics and 11 first aid stations



THE OCCUPATION AND DESTRUCTION CONSEQUENCES ON THE COMMUNITY



► The beginning of the occupation of the community took place on the first day of the invasion of the Russian Federation - February 24, 2022, when at 1:30 p.m. local time with the first shelling of the occupying forces of Russia that took place on the village of Rivnopilla of the Novyi Bilous territorial community

► On March 3, 2022, there was a full occupation of settlements in the Novyi Bilous community

► On April 01-02, 2022, about 2,000 units of armored and military equipment, which participated in the offensive on Chernihiv and Kyiv, were withdrawn through the territory of the Novyi Bilous territorial community by regular units of the Russian Federation

► During the period of occupation, 42 civilians, residents of the community, died

► 195 residents of the community were left homeless

The fiercest battles on the territory of the community between regular units of the Russian Federation and units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine took place in the area of the village of Rivnopillia and the military airfield "Pivtsi" in the area of the village of Polubotky



CONSEQUENCES OF THE OCCUPATION AND DESTRUCTION ON THE COMMUNITY

465 buildings were damaged (with an area of 42,605 m²), including 2 two-story multi-apartment residential building in Novyi Bilous Community.

Among the listed buildings of the housing stock, 71 objects were damaged by more than 50% .





CONSEQUENCES OF OCCUPATION AND DESTRUCTION IN THE COMMUNITY

The community's budgetary institutions were also damaged, namely:

- ▶ 4 educational institutions
- 3 healthcare institutions
- 6 administrative buildings in starostas

A new school bus purchased at the expense of the community in 2021 was destroyed and 2 school buses were damaged by mortar fire.





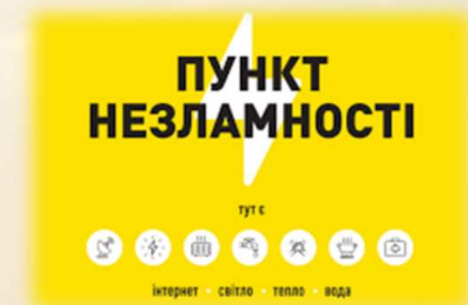
ORGANIZATION OF CIVIL PROTECTION IN THE COMMUNITY

The armed aggression of the Russian Federation has left behind a significant danger for the local population due to the possibility of air strikes or terrorist acts, so for collective protection against factors arising from hostilities or terrorist acts, it is necessary to provide the community population with civil defense protective structures (shelters) and an appropriate warning system for community residents.



Today, the community alert system is organized through the Air Alert mobile application developed with the support of the Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine, which allows you to instantly receive civil defense notifications on your smartphone.

► In 3 starostas, the work of invincibility points (a project of the Ukrainian authorities) was organized, which were deployed against the backdrop of massive shelling of critical infrastructure during the Russian-Ukrainian war, providing heat, water, electricity, mobile communications, etc.



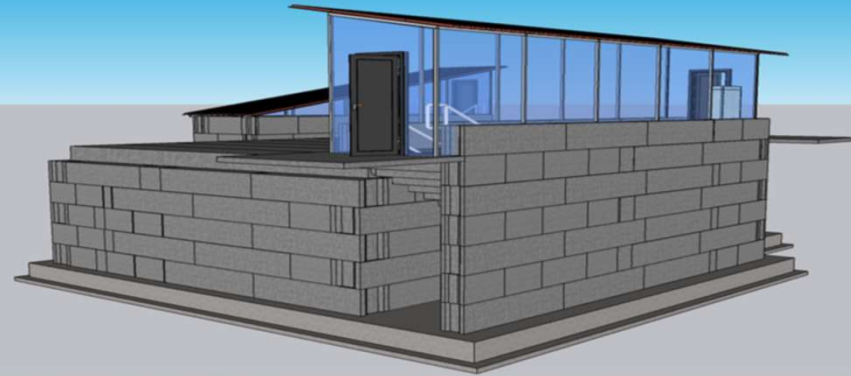


The Organization of Civil Protection in the Community

► The Internal notification systems and alarm notification systems have been installed in 9 schools and kindergartens of the community



► 6 shelters in educational institutions, in accordance with the requirements of the law have been created to ensure access to educational services in the de-occupied territory of the Novyi Bilous territorial community



►► 7 educational institutions of the community still require shelters among them 3 institutions are newly built.

Such shelters can also be used to protect the civilian population of the community.



THE LIFE OF A TERRITORIAL COMMUNITY DURING THE WAR

Life under occupation means living under the laws of "machine gun law," shelling, and active hostilities.

Under the occupation, the work of local authorities was aimed at supporting community residents:

- food, medicine, water, and backup power sources.
- organization of communication, sheltering the population from shelling.



- informing the population about the real situation around the community.

- Organizing the evacuation of civilians through safe areas.

In addition, the units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and the terrorist defense were informed about the location of the occupation units and the local population provided comprehensive assistance to the military.

AREAS OF POSSIBLE COOPERATION AND NEEDS FOR RECOVERY



7 educational institutions of the community need shelters. 3 of them are newly built institutions that can also be used for sheltering the civilian population of the community.



The park of school buses critical needs of replenishment.

The receiving technical assistance in the form of specialized utility equipment for the utility company "Redkivske" of the Novyi Bilous village council.



The "Drinking Water" project - ensuring stable and uninterrupted operation of water delivery in the territory of the community, to provide high-quality water supply services.

AREAS OF POSSIBLE COOPERATION AND NEEDS FOR RECOVERY



Ensuring sustainable energy supply to public sector institutions in the community through renewable and alternative energy sources.
